

Hello, and thank you for taking the time to read about Forces Support, This is what we do.....

Forces Support was set up in honour of all our brave men and women who have been killed in action in the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts, or while serving with-in these times, with the intention of Honouring our Fallen Heroes with our pledge not to forget their families.

We are the only UK charity providing this type of support

We provide general maintenance around the home and garden, the work the lost family member would have done for his or her family. Or the jobs that have built up while a family grieves.

We have just 2 professional builders and 2 maintenance men a CEO and an admin assistant and we have provided national support throughout England, Scotland and Wales for approximately two years and supported almost 100 families.

Due to word of mouth from the families of our fallen heroes spreading the word about our service and the difference we have made to their lives, we have been swamped with applications and have over 50 families waiting for our support and we desperately need financial support to expand our staff and support teams. Our waiting list is now 6-7 months long.
